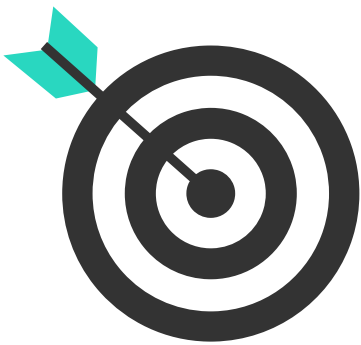


THE LITERACY LAB YEAR AT A GLANCE

- Serve full-time for one service term in a Pre-K classroom or elementary school
- Administer scripted, data-backed literacy interventions to students
- Receive year-round training, coaching, and support
- Monitor student progress to make data-informed decisions
